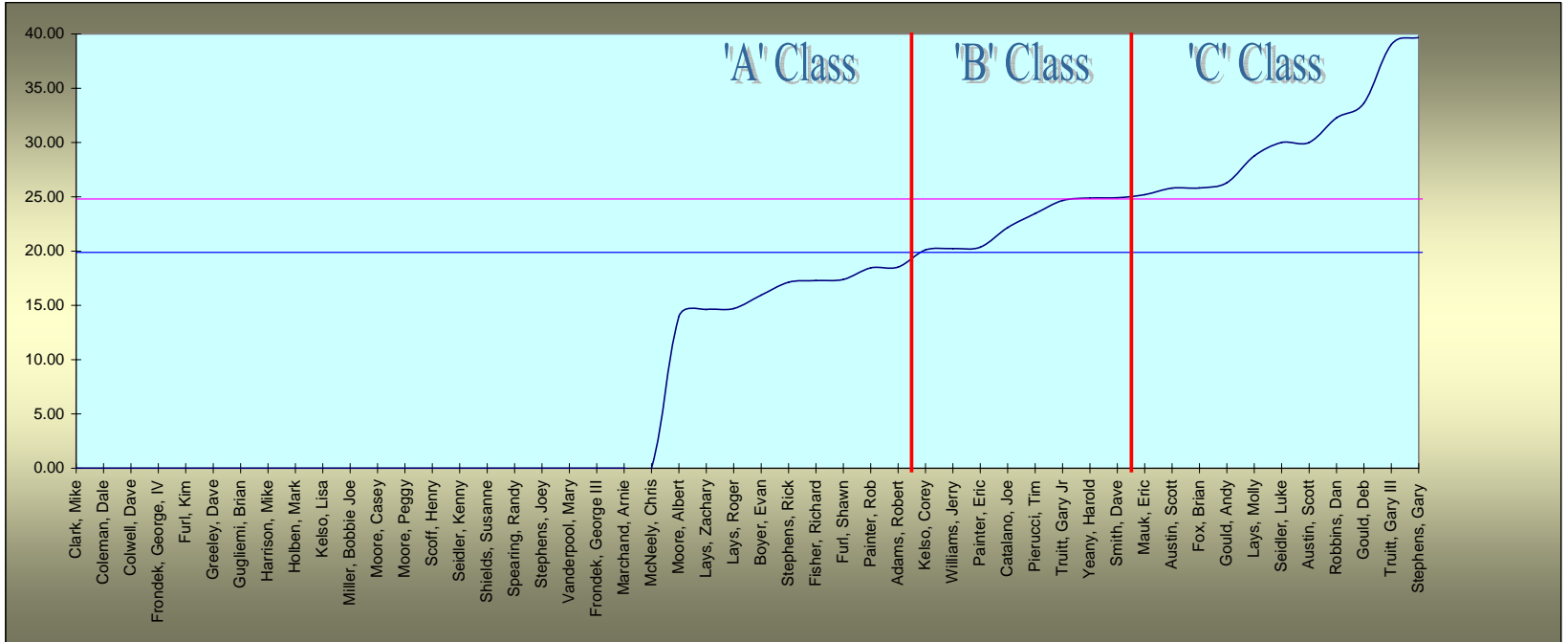

**Definition:** A classification shoot will consist of 5 individual targets positioned 7 yards from the shooter. On the buzzer, the shooter will draw his pistol - with a round in the chamber, fire one round into each target, reload, and repeat, for a total of two reloads and 3 rounds in each target. Scoring will include hits, misses, and time.

Classifications are designed to give every shooter a chance to assess skills versus similarly skilled shooters. Lacking a classification score, it has been determined that unclassified shooters will remain in 'A' class until their skills are assessed. Event points and season points are dependent on shooter class, so it is in the best interest of each shooter to ensure they are properly classified. Any shooter who wishes to classify or re-classify to ensure they are matched with similar-skilled shooters, please notify the club prior to, or on the day of a regularly scheduled shoot and a classification shoot will be arranged.

**NOTE: Adjustments will be made to the classifications groupings to keep a balanced number of shooters in each class. Therefore, it is possible that a particular shooter's classification may change even if he has not re-classified. Class and Season Standings scores will be based on a shooter's classification for each individual event, and will not be adjusted forward or back.**

**In the interest of fair and constant record-keeping, effective July 1, 2009, this system will be utilized in an ongoing manner to ensure accurate classifications. Updates will be applied as they come in. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.**
